7. Read the following Passage and answer the questions given below:

First, it must be emphasized that non-violent resistance is not a method for cowards; it does resist. If one uses this method because he is afraid of merely because he lacks the instruments of violence, he is not truly non-violent. This is why Gandhi ji often said that if cowardice is the only alternative to violence, it is better to fight. He made this statement conscious of the fact that there is always another alternative; no individual or group need submit to any wrong, nor need they use violence to right the wrong; there is way of non-violent resistance. This is ultimately the way of the strong men. The method is passive physically, but strongly active spiritually. It is not passive non-resistance to evil, it is active non-violent resistance to evil.

A Second basic fact that characterizes non-violence is that it does not seek to defeat or humiliate the opponent's but to win his friendship and understanding. The non-violent resister must often express his protest through non-cooperation or boycotts, but he realizes that these are not ends themselves; they are merely means to awaken a sense of moral shame in the opponent. The end is redemption and reconciliation. The aftermath of non-violence is the creation of the beloved community, while the aftermath of violence is tragic bitterness.
